Parent Access (for all students)

Parent Access will open on Monday, September 10th. Parent access allows you to change your contact information, including how you wish to receive email and phone calls from the alert system. You are able to view any emails sent from the alert system in Parent Access. For grades 3-8, you will also be able to see your student's assignments and grades.

This week, new families will receive information on how to set up an account in your child(ren)'s take home folder. If your child(ren) attended School of the Incarnation last year, but you never set up an account, please send an email to Mrs. Oshenska at joshenska@schooloftheincarnation.org requesting an Access ID and password. If you created an account but cannot remember your username or password, also send an email to Mrs. Oshenska asking for your password to be reset. Middle school students will be receiving usernames and passwords for student access on their iPads.
