Black Friday Re-Enrollment 2026-2027 School Year Sale

Re-enrollment for the 2026-2027 school year for all current SOTI students begins on Friday, November 28th. This year we are excited to offer our very own Black Friday Sale, which also includes a chance to win a tuition credit prize! The link to the active 2026-2027 re-enrollment portal will be sent the morning of Black Friday.

Complete the intent to re-enroll form and payment between 8:00 AM on Black Friday, November 28, 2025 and midnight on Cyber Monday, December 1, 2025 and pay the discounted fee of \$100 per student. Student accounts with the intent to re-enroll form and payment completed during the sale period will be entered into a drawing, and the winner will be awarded a \$2,500 tuition credit for the 2026-2027 school year*.

The regular re-enrollment fee schedule for the 2026-2027 school year is

- \$120/student if paid between December 2nd and January 10th.
- \$200/student if paid between January 11th and January 31st
- \$250/student if paid between February 1st and February 15th
- If not paid by February 15th, your child's spot will be released.

*The tuition credit is non-transferable and is a credit for the 2026-2027 tuition only. This is not a cash voucher.

Grandparents & Special Friends Day


We can't wait to see all of our Grandparents and Special Friends on November 25, 2025! It is going to be a special day for our very special guests!


We wish you all a wonderful Christmas break!

If you can't find the answer you are looking for, please contact Meghan Brown at mbrown@schooloftheincarnation.org.

What is Grandparents and Special Friends Day? What can we expect?

This is a special event that allows our students to share SOTI with someone important in their life. Grandparents and special friends will gather in Marian Hall to hear from Ms. Baker about the wonderful things happening at SOTI every day. Then, they will have the opportunity to join their student in the classroom for visits full of hospitality, game playing and a special snack prepared for them by their student.

What time should grandparents arrive?

Grandparents should arrive no earlier than 15 minutes before their session starts to keep the parking lot moving smoothly.

Where do grandparents enter campus?

Grandparents should enter through the lower gate, just as you would for morning drop off.

Where should grandparents park?

We hope that many grandparents and special friends can attend this wonderful event! Please keep in mind that parking is limited on campus. Teachers and staff will be parking on the field, to allow for the entire lot (including the late lot) to be open for grandparents. There will be staff members in the lot to direct traffic. We also suggest carpooling if multiple grandparents and special friends from one family are attending the event. Another low-stress option is to arrange a ride from family members to drop off at the front door, so that visitors won't need to worry about parking at all.

What should we do if our Grandparent or special friend has mobility issues and requires assistance?

Please indicate that assistance is required in the appropriate space on the Registration Form. Someone will contact you to discuss arrangements.

Where should grandparents go upon arrival?

All visitors will check in at the registration tables located outside the front entrance of the school. From there, grandparents will be directed to Marian Hall. Student ambassadors will be in the lobby and hallways to escort our guests. Classroom visits will follow.

What should I do if my grandparent has more than one grandchild in the same session?

Grandparents can divide up between their students, or the older student may attend the program in the younger sibling's classroom. Please indicate your plans on the registration form.

What if a grandparent has students in more than one session?

Grandparents who are staying for consecutive sessions may return to Marian Hall at the conclusion of the classroom portion of the previous session. They do not need to return to the registration table. Grandparents who have a break in between sessions may choose to leave and return for their final session or they may return to Marian Hall and enjoy a cup of coffee while they wait for their final session to begin.

Will there be refreshments served?

As an act of service and gratitude, we ask that each student pack a snack to share with their grandparent or special friend. We encourage the students to complete this with as little parental assistance as possible so that the snack is truly a gift from them to their special guest. Coffee will be available in Marian Hall.

Can the student leave with his/her grandparent or special friend?

Students who have been given parental permission on the registration form may leave with a grandparent or special friend at the conclusion of the classroom visit. Students will be signed out directly from their classroom. Please note: ALL GUESTS WHO ARE PERMITTED TO SIGN OUT STUDENTS MUST PROVIDE A **VALID PHOTO I.D.**

What if my grandparent is going to multiple sessions? How will he/she sign out my other children?

At the conclusion of their final session, the grandparent should sign out the student they are with directly from the classroom. The grandparents and that child should then report to the front desk to have the remaining siblings signed out and called from their classrooms.

What if my student does not leave with his/her grandparent or special friend?

Your child will follow the normal dismissal procedures.

Should my child come to school if they do not have any guests attending?

Yes! While Grandparents & Special Friends Day is a special event where relatives can bond and see your children in action at school, we will take special care in ensuring that all of our students—whether they have a visitor or not—feel included during the day. If you choose for your student to stay at home, please follow the normal procedure for notifying the school of an absence.



New Family Referral Program

Our current Incarnation families are by far the best ambassadors for spreading the word about our school! Our New Family Referral Program rewards current families with a one-time \$250 tuition credit for referring a new family who applies and enrolls. Here's how it works:

- If you know of a family that you believe may be interested in School of the Incarnation, complete the "New Family Referral Form" below and submit to the school office.
- Reach out to the family and share your experiences at School of the Incarnation. Share with them the reasons you have chosen Catholic education and why you think they should do the same. Let them know that you have or will refer their information to the school and that an admissions representative will call or email them to provide more information.
- For each new family that applies and enrolls at least one full-time student, a \$250 tuition credit will be awarded to the current referring family after the new student has been in attendance for 30 days.
- Siblings of current students and previously enrolled students do not qualify as new families. Staff members are not eligible for the referral credit.
- Note that this form must be on file in the front office before the new family has contacted the school on their
 own for information or to visit so it is best to submit the form as soon as possible after speaking with the new
 family. In other words, the referral form is not retroactive and you are not eligible for the referral if the family
 contacts school before the referral.
- This referral program is open to all families with students currently enrolled in PreK4-Grade 8.
- Referral fees are limited to one per family per academic year.
