From the Principal's Desk

Dear Parents,

Last Friday, we sent home a letter from the Archdiocese regarding the coronavirus. As stated in that letter, we are taking appropriate precautions in keeping with best practices and monitoring the situation in conjunction with the Archdiocese. As a school community, we have also made sure to take stock of our inventory of cleaning/disinfecting supplies as well as supplies for our health room to ensure that we have a reasonable amount of supplies on hand.

Although we are paying special attention to the coronavirus, we don't want to downplay other illnesses such as the flu, colds, and "stomach bugs." If your child is not well, it is always a good idea to keep them home for evaluation and observation. Attached to this newsletter is the "Considerations for Keeping Your Child Home" memo that we have previously sent home from the Health Room.

A special note about lice. We have been having a difficult time with lice this year in a few grades. Just as a reminder, if you detect lice, the school should be notified (via the school nurse) and it needs to receive treatment before coming back to school. Upon return to school, the child will need to be evaluated by the school nurse before being readmitted to class.

We want to keep our students as healthy and safe as possible, and it takes a team effort. Thank you for your cooperation. If you have any questions, please feel free to reach out to our wonderful school nurse, Sue Toth stoth@schooloftheincarnation.org.

Dear Parents or Guardians:

To prevent widespread illness in school, we recommend that your child stay home from school if experiencing flu or cold symptoms. To decide whether or not to send your child to school, please consider the following guidelines:

Consider keeping your child at home for an extra day of rest and observation if he/she has any of the following symptoms:

- Very stuffy or runny nose and/or cough
- Mild sore throat (no fever, no known exposure to strep)
- Headache
- Mild stomach ache

Definitely keep your child home for treatment and observation if he/she has any of these symptoms:

- Fever greater than 100 degrees by mouth. Your child may return to school only after his/her temperature has been consistently below 100 degrees, by mouth, for a minimum of 24 hours without medication intervention.
- Vomiting or diarrhea, even once. Your child may return to school only after waiting a period of 24 hours from the last bought of vomiting or diarrhea with no medication intervention.
- Chills
- General malaise or feelings of fatigue, weakness or muscle aches.
- Frequent congested (wet) or croupy cough.
- Lots of nasal congestion with frequent blowing of nose.

To help prevent the spread of flu and colds, teach your children good hygiene habits:

- Wash hands frequently and well.
- Turn off the water faucet with a paper towel instead of using your freshly cleaned hands.
- Keep hands away from your eyes, nose and mouth.
- Cover mouth and nose when sneezing or coughing use a tissue, throw it away directly and then wash hands or cough into your inner elbow.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.

A child who has started antibiotics has to be on medication for 24 hours before considered non-contagious and able to return to school. Often when a child awakens with vague complaints (the way colds and the flu begin) it is wise to observe your child at home for an hour or two before deciding whether or not to bring them to school. Sending children to school to "see how they do" or instructing them to go to the school nurse and call you if they can't make it or feel worse is not advisable. Your child should be physically able to participate in all school activities on return to school. Keeping a sick child at home will minimize the spread of infections and viruses to other students, faculty and staff. Lastly, please consider getting your child the flu vaccine each year.

Thank you in advance for helping make this year as healthy as possible!

New Family Referral Program

Our current Incarnation families are by far the best ambassadors for spreading the word about our school! Our New Family Referral Program rewards current families with a one-time \$250 tuition credit for referring a new family who applies and enrolls. Here's how it works:

- If you know of a family that you believe may be interested in School of the Incarnation, complete the "New Family Referral Form" below and submit to the school office.
- Reach out to the family and share your experiences at School of the Incarnation. Share with them the reasons you have chosen Catholic education and why you think they should do the same. Let them know that you have or will refer their information to the school and that an admissions representative will call or email them to provide more information.
- For each new family that applies and enrolls at least one full-time student, a \$250 tuition credit will be awarded to the current referring family after the new student has been in attendance for 30 days.
- Siblings of current students and previously enrolled students do not qualify as new families. Staff members are not eligible for the referral credit.
- Note that this form must be on file in the front office before the new family has contacted the school on their
 own for information or to visit so it is best to submit the form as soon as possible after speaking with the new
 family. In other words, the referral form is not retroactive and you are not eligible for the referral if the family
 contacts school before the referral.
- This referral program is open to all families with students currently enrolled in PreK4-Grade 8.
- Referral fees are limited to one per family per academic year.
