From the Health Room

Please remember to pick up your child's medication from the Health Room. All unclaimed medications will be disposed of after June 13th. Only adults may pick up medications - students are not permitted to carry medicine to, from or in school for safety reasons. If you need to make alternate arrangements or would like us to hold medication(s) for summer camp, please email stoth@schooloftheincarnation.org with these requests.

Summer Health Checklist:

- PreK & Kindergarten: Submit School Physical (Parts I & II) and Immunization Report before school starts.
- **Students with medical conditions** (e.g. allergies, asthma, seizures, etc.): Provide updated Care Plans and Medication Administration forms. All forms and medications are due on or before the first day of school.
- **Medications:** Must match what's listed on the forms, be in original, unopened packaging, and not expire during the school year if possible. Submit a separate Medication Administration form for each medication, whether it is prescription or over-the-counter.
- Immunizations: Make sure your child is up to date. Of note: 7th & 8th graders must have MCV4 and Tdap vaccines.
- **Sports Physicals:** Required for middle school students playing sports. This is a separate form from the School Physical.
- Health Updates: Let us know of any new medical concerns.
- Forms: Available on our school website under Resources > Forms and Documents.

Summer Work and School Supplies

Teachers have prepared summer work (K-8) and supply lists for the 25-26 school year. The purpose of summer work is to help students retain the learning and growth that they have made throughout the year so that they are ready to hit the ground running when they return. To that end, it is better to spend time working on these assignments incrementally over the course of the summer rather than waiting until right before school returns to complete them. Summer work will be posted on SOTI Studies, and you should look at the grade level that your child will be entering in the 25-26 school year. For example, a current kindergarten student will complete the summer work for the rising 1st graders. At the end of the summer, the summer work is turned in to their new teachers. All summer work is entered as a graded assignment in T1.

Supply lists for the 25-26 school year will also be posted on the school website.

New Family Referral Program

Our current Incarnation families are by far the best ambassadors for spreading the word about our school! Our New Family Referral Program rewards current families with a one-time \$250 tuition credit for referring a new family who applies and enrolls. Here's how it works:

- If you know of a family that you believe may be interested in School of the Incarnation, complete the "New Family Referral Form" below and submit to the school office.
- Reach out to the family and share your experiences at School of the Incarnation. Share with them the reasons you have chosen Catholic education and why you think they should do the same. Let them know that you have or will refer their information to the school and that an admissions representative will call or email them to provide more information.
- For each new family that applies and enrolls at least one full-time student, a \$250 tuition credit will be awarded to the current referring family after the new student has been in attendance for 30 days.
- Siblings of current students and previously enrolled students do not qualify as new families. Staff members are not eligible for the referral credit.
- Note that this form must be on file in the front office before the new family has contacted the school on their
 own for information or to visit so it is best to submit the form as soon as possible after speaking with the new
 family. In other words, the referral form is not retroactive and you are not eligible for the referral if the family
 contacts school before the referral.
- This referral program is open to all families with students currently enrolled in PreK4-Grade 8.
- Referral fees are limited to one per family per academic year.
