Re-enrollment for current students for 2022-2023

The re-enrollment process to secure your child's seat at School of the Incarnation for the 2022-2023 is open now. It is important for us to know which students are returning before we begin to offer spots to new applicants. Please check for the email sent last Thursday with instructions on how to log in to the parent portal in School Admin to complete the "Intent to Re-Enroll" Form and pay the re-enrollment fee. The re-enrollment fee will go up according to the fee schedule below.

\$100 if paid by January 15th

\$150 if paid between January 16th and January 31st\$200 if paid between February 1st and February 15thIf not paid by February 15th, your child's spot will be released.

The intent to re-enroll and payment of the fee is the first step in the re-enrollment process. The second step includes the signing of your contract, initiating your FACTS agreement, and payment of the tuition deposit. This will be launched in early February with a deadline of March 6, 2022. The first tuition payment will be in July 2022.

We require the intent to re-enroll from each student who is enrolled this year. If you know you are not reenrolling for 2022-2023, please complete the form with your intent to not enroll.

Wine Food and Brew News - Our Out of Uniform fundraiser is back by popular demand!!

Here's how the out of uniform pass pricing works (EVENT PRICE ONLY):

• If you have two children, the cost is \$20 each (total \$40). If you have more than two children, each additional child will only cost \$10. (Example: 4 children=\$60, 5 children=\$70, etc.)

• Staff members may purchase an out of uniform for the week too! The price structure will work the same. Staff member will be \$20, first child would also be \$20, and additional children would be \$10 each.

AFTER EVENT PRICE - Available until 2/25/2022 (the after-event purchase link will become available after the day of the event)

• If you have two children, the cost is \$25 each (total \$50). If you have more than two children, each additional child will only cost \$15. (Example: 4 children=\$80, 5 children=\$95, etc.)

• Staff members may purchase an out of uniform for the week too! The price structure will work the same. Staff member will be \$25, first child would also be \$25, and additional children would be \$15 each.

UPDATE:

In person sessions for the Beyond Program clubs were suspended until January 14th in response to the surge in Covid-19 cases. We're hopeful to be able to resume meetings next week, but please read emails from school for confirmation about your child's particular club.

Prior to Christmas break, the following clubs enjoyed their sessions: Chess Club: The nice weather allowed for outside game playing to practice skills and learn new "moves" to try. Club members enjoy learning from and teaching one another.

Coding and Technology Club: Students have explored block coding, typing skills, programming and trying to navigate Sphero robots, as well as learning about and then creating paper circuits.

Knightly Readers Book Club: The club members have been reading and discussing "Mrs. Frisby and the Rats of NIMH" during their meetings.

The Arts and Crafts Clubs: Christmas centered projects were made by students during meetings in Dec. The preschool and kindergarten group created a Santa mask, reindeer puppet, scratch art pictures, decorated wooden ornaments, and made cards for the Giving Back: Linda's Legacy organization. The 3rd-5th graders learned the steps involved with basic sewing skills and then used felt fabric to make colorful light bulb ornaments. They also made scratch art pictures and chenille stem candy canes.

The Knightly News Team: For the school's newspaper team, students have been learning about the sections and typical jobs associated with creating a newspaper. Students were assigned events or topics to research during Dec. and Jan. in order to prepare for their first published edition.

Four year, full tuition scholarships to students for Catholic schools!

General Requirements

- Geography—Students and families must reside in, be registered in a Catholic parish and have applied to a Catholic school in one of the eligible areas.
 (Elementary students: Catholic PARISH schools only.)
- ◆ Age—4th grade students apply for 5th—8th grade;
 8th grade students apply for 9th—12th grade.
- Religion—Students must be baptized Catholics or officially convert into the Catholic Church.

Academic Requirements

◆ *Grades*—First and second quarter grades must be a minimum numeric grade of 93 in each of these areas:

English/Language Arts/Reading Math Social Studies Science

Standardized Testing

- 4th graders must score in the 92th percentile or above on the SCANTRON Performance Series test in Reading, Math, and Language.
- 8th graders must score in the 94th percentile or above in the SCANTRON Performance Series test in Reading, Math, and Language and MUST ALSO have a composite score in the 95th percentile or above on the High School Placement Test.

New Family Referral Program



Our current Incarnation families are by far the best ambassadors for spreading the word about our school! Our New Family Referral Program rewards current families with a one-time \$250 tuition credit for referring a new family who applies and enrolls. Here's how it works:

- If you know of a family that you believe may be interested in School of the Incarnation, complete the "New Family Referral Form" below and submit to the school office.
- Reach out to the family and share your experiences at School of the Incarnation. Share with them the reasons you have chosen Catholic education and why you think they should do the same. Let them know that you have or will refer their information to the school and that an admissions representative will call or email them to provide more information.
- For each new family that applies and enrolls at least one full-time student, a \$250 tuition credit will be awarded to the current referring family <u>after the new student has been in attendance for 30 days.</u>
- Siblings of current students and previously enrolled students do not qualify as new families. Staff members are not eligible for the referral credit.
- Note that this form must be on file in the front office before the new family has contacted the school on their own for information or to visit so it is best to submit the form as soon as possible after speaking with the new family. In other words, the referral form is not retroactive and you are not eligible for the referral if the family contacts school before the referral.
- This referral program is open to all families with students currently enrolled in PreK4-Grade 8.
- Referral fees are limited to one per family per academic year.
