Re-enrollment for current students for 2023-2024

The re-enrollment process to secure your child's seat at School of the Incarnation for the 2023-2024 is open now. It is important for us to know which students are returning before we begin to offer spots to new applicants. Please check for the email sent this morning with instructions on how to login to the parent portal in School Admin to complete the "Intent to Re-Enroll" Form and pay the re-enrollment fee. The re-enrollment fee will go up according to the fee schedule below.

\$100 if paid by January 15th
\$150 if paid between January 16th and January 30th
\$200 if paid between January 31st and February 15th
If not paid by February 15th, your child's spot will be released.

The intent to re-enroll and payment of the fee is the first step in the re-enrollment process. The second step includes the signing of your contract, initiating your FACTS agreement, and payment of the tuition deposit. This will be launched in early February with a deadline of March 15, 2023. The first tuition payment will be in July 2023.

We require the intent to re-enroll from each student who is enrolled this year. If you know you are not reenrolling for 2023-2024, please complete the form with your intent to not enroll.

FACTS Grant and Aid Applications

FACTS Grant and Aid Applications are now open for the 2023-2024 school year. The deadline to apply for Grant and Aid will be February 28, 2023. There will not be any exceptions to this deadline. FACTS is the validation software used by the Archdiocese of Baltimore, the school, and the parishes to verify the applications. FACTS does not provide any aid. Aid is awarded by the AOB, the school and parishes. Dear 3rd, 4th, & 5th Grade Families,

Students will begin playing Recorders in January! Recorders are an essential part of the music curriculum because it teaches students music literacy, rhythm, and fine motor skills on an instrument. All students are required to have their own Recorder-no sharing between family members please. It is very important that students bring their own recorder to class each week. Students will be allowed to bring their recorder home to practice or they may leave it at school so it is here for Music Class each week. If they bring it home, please make sure they bring it back to school on their Music Day.

If you have a recorder from a previous school year, you may use the one you purchased that year.

If you need a recorder: Go to the Diamondmind link below and fill out the form and payment information to order a recorder. The cost is \$6.00.

<u>Please do not purchase a recorder online or at another store</u>. We are ordering enough for the entire 3rd grade and any new students in 4th & 5th.

Students should bring their recorder to school beginning in January. Please try to order the recorder as soon as you are able so they can have it for the first lesson. We will begin learning the recorders once the order has been delivered in January.

I realize that Recorders can be very loud and squeaky, but, being a Flute performer myself, I work very hard to help the students sound musical. I do work on proper playing technique to avoid the squeaks and squawks. Please reach out to me if you need tips for helping them to play in a more pleasing way or if you have any questions about ordering a recorder. Dear School of the Incarnation Families,

School of the Incarnation is committed to proper safety measures, transparent communication, and adapting to changing COVID conditions. Our primary focus is on keeping the well-being of our students, faculty, and staff as our top priority.

In accord with the most recent guidance, we will report positive COVID- 19 cases on a weekly basis. School-wide notifications of such cases will be sent out on Thursdays via the School Newsletter. We will not be contact tracing and identifying close contacts within school.

The following positive Covid cases have been reported in our school community:

- Staff member in the Fifth grade. Last day in school was 1/3/23.
- Staff member in the Administration wing. Last day in school was 1/3/23.
- Staff member in the Business Office. Last day in school was 1/4/23.

We encourage you to continue to actively monitor the health of your child daily and be alert to any of the major symptoms of COVID; including, but not limited to, fever, cough, sore throat, and shortness of breath. Masking is optional unless directed to do so by a health official after a quarantine. The school is not responsible for enforcing any individual masking preferences or obligations. Should any concerning symptoms appear, please contact your medical professional and alert the school office at 410-519-2285.

New Family Referral Program



Our current Incarnation families are by far the best ambassadors for spreading the word about our school! Our New Family Referral Program rewards current families with a one-time \$250 tuition credit for referring a new family who applies and enrolls. Here's how it works:

- If you know of a family that you believe may be interested in School of the Incarnation, complete the "New Family Referral Form" below and submit to the school office.
- Reach out to the family and share your experiences at School of the Incarnation. Share with them the reasons you have chosen Catholic education and why you think they should do the same. Let them know that you have or will refer their information to the school and that an admissions representative will call or email them to provide more information.
- For each new family that applies and enrolls at least one full-time student, a \$250 tuition credit will be awarded to the current referring family <u>after the new student has been in attendance for 30 days.</u>
- Siblings of current students and previously enrolled students do not qualify as new families. Staff members are not eligible for the referral credit.
- Note that this form must be on file in the front office before the new family has contacted the school on their own for information or to visit so it is best to submit the form as soon as possible after speaking with the new family. In other words, the referral form is not retroactive and you are not eligible for the referral if the family contacts school before the referral.
- This referral program is open to all families with students currently enrolled in PreK4-Grade 8.
- Referral fees are limited to one per family per academic year.
