TOMORROW!! Tag Day - Friday, December 20th

Tomorrow, Friday, December 20th is a Tag Day. Students may dress out of uniform. The theme is "Christmas" and students are asked to wear red/green/Christmas attire. Students who have PE on Fridays must wear sneakers. The cost to dress out-of-uniform is \$1 – dollar bills only please – no coins. The money collected will be donated to Giving Back. *Please remember – Friday, December 20th is a 12:15 dismissal day and there will be no afterschool ESP.

ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL TOMORROW

Tomorrow is a half day with no ESP. This means there will be more cars than usual attempting to pick up their students at the end of the day, resulting in roughly 1 gajillion people trying to leave all at once. We are doing our best to help relieve congestion.

First, all early dismissals must be finished by 11:15 so as to allow our Formal Dismissal to proceed uninterrupted.

Next, many parents are going to be in the school to help with Christmas Festivities. Please note these particular instructions. If you are dropping off party items in the morning during Drop-off and then are leaving the school, you may park in the Gold Lot and then exit with the regular traffic flow. If you are arriving with Morning Drop-Off but plan on staying for the entire day, please park in the Maroon Lot strip reserved for guests. Any parents who arrive during the day to attend parties and plan to leave before 11:15 should park around the exit loop/HOV lane. Any parents who arrive during the day and plan to dismiss at 12:15 should park in their standard Maroon or Gold Parking lines even if you are arriving very early. To help ease traffic, consider carpooling, making sure to notify your child's homeroom teacher.

Finally, thank you in advance for your patience and have a Blessed Christmas!

Reenrollment for School Year 2020-2021 -- Coming soon!

The re-enrollment process to secure your child's seat at School of the Incarnation for the 2020-2021 will open soon. It is important for us to know which students are returning before we begin to offer spots to new applicants. You will receive a separate email when you can login to the parent portal to complete the "Intent to Re-Enroll" Form and re-registration fee. The re-enrollment deadline is January 31st. The re-enrollment fee will again be \$100 per student if paid by January 15th.

New Family Referral Program



Our current Incarnation families are by far the best ambassadors for spreading the word about our school! Our New Family Referral Program rewards current families with a one-time \$250 tuition credit for referring a new family who applies and enrolls. Here's how it works:

- If you know of a family that you believe may be interested in School of the Incarnation, complete the "New Family Referral Form" below and submit to the school office.
- Reach out to the family and share your experiences at School of the Incarnation. Share with them the reasons you have chosen Catholic education and why you think they should do the same. Let them know that you have or will refer their information to the school and that an admissions representative will call or email them to provide more information.
- For each new family that applies and enrolls at least one full-time student, a \$250 tuition credit will be awarded to the current referring family <u>after the new student has been in attendance for 30 days.</u>
- Siblings of current students and previously enrolled students do not qualify as new families. Staff members are not eligible for the referral credit.
- Note that this form must be on file in the front office before the new family has contacted the school on their own for information or to visit so it is best to submit the form as soon as possible after speaking with the new family. In other words, the referral form is not retroactive and you are not eligible for the referral if the family contacts school before the referral.
- This referral program is open to all families with students currently enrolled in PreK4-Grade 8.
- Referral fees are limited to one per family per academic year.

 Rental Property - send Schedule E (page 1)
 S-Corporation - send Schedule E (page 2), Form 1120S (5 pages), Schedule K-1 and Form 8825
 Partnership - send Schedule E (page 2), Form 1065 (5 pages), Schedule K-1 and Form 8825
 Estates and Trusts - send Schedule E (page 2), Form 1041 and Schedule K-1

If you do not file a tax return, you are required to provide documentation of all income received.

All documentation received is imaged upon receipt and then destroyed.

You may log in to your FACTS user account to review the status of your application. Please allow 2 weeks processing time before inquiring further about receipt and/or status of the uploaded documents. Application deadlines are set by the institution awarding the aid. If you are applying after the deadline, contact your school to ensure that your application will be accepted.

A non-refundable application fee may be required before your application will be submitted.

NOTE: Award decisions are made by the institution providing the financial aid, not FACTS.
