#### **UPDATES:**

The Environmental Club: Caring for Creation group members have been learning about birds and other animals during their final sessions. They will also build, paint, and decorate birdhouses to take home in order to help care for some of the birds in their own yards.

Our three running clubs, Guys on the Go, Maroon Junior Joggers, and Gold Junior Joggers are continuing to work on endurance and running skills in preparation for their "Fun Run" event that will take place in May at the school.

The Arts and Crafts Club members will expand upon their painting skills by creating projects using watercolors, acrylics, and specialized "Mandala" tools that provide various fun details to their masterpieces. ## Dear SOTI Family,

We are so happy to share information about this year's summer camps! In addition to the traditional **Summer Knights Camps (Gr. K-4),** we will continue to offer 4 weeks of **Summer Social Camps** for students in grades 5-8! **All grade levels refer to the 2022-2023 school year.** 

Both camp programs will be operating under the school's ESP Program, but will be two distinct day programs. Mrs. Shai and Mrs. Bucci will be coordinating the camps for Gr. K-4, and Mr. Smith will be coordinating the camps for grades 5-8. Below is information for both programs, and a calendar for the scheduled camps.

Each **Summer Knights Camp** lasts one week and is independent of the other weeks. Families can choose the weeks that work best for them. These camps consist of age appropriate activities and in house field trips which follow the theme for the week. Vacation Bible School is actually run by St. Joseph Parish, but takes place at SOTI.

Each **Summer Social Camps** lasts one week and is independent of the other weeks. Families can choose the weeks that work best for them. There are two weeks in June and two in July. These camps will consist of age appropriate activities and games to allow the students to spend time with their peers having fun while being active indoors and out. This also includes short day trips for activities such as minigolf or bowling.

\*Special note for 5th grade parents. Fifth grade students participating in summer camps, will spend the morning in the older group (Summer Social Camps). You may choose to have them leave at 12:15 PM with the students in grades 6-8. If you wish for your 5th grader to remain for the full day, they would transition to the Summer Knight Camp from 12:15-4:00 PM. See below for pricing information

Not ready to go home at 11pm?


No problem! Blackwall Barn and Lodge is open on Friday evenings until 1am.

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Seventh grade students are scheduled to take the pre-HSPT in class next week on Tuesday, May 3rd. This practice test helps them prepare for the HSPT (High School Placement Test), which is required in eighth grade for any student who plans to apply to a Catholic high school. The pre-HSPT will begin immediately after Morning Prayer, and it should last approximately two and a half to three hours, including breaks. On the morning of the test, it is important for students to eat a substantial breakfast, and they should also bring a water bottle to school. Please, note that late arrivals will not be admitted once the test is underway. Therefore, it will be important for students to arrive at school on time.

We are offering an optional early dismissal at noon on the day of the test, and a signed permission slip will be required for release from school. Those students who choose to remain in school should bring a bag lunch, and teachers will be showing a movie. (The title will be announced soon, with the usual prerogative to "opt out.") Students who have an official accommodation plan that allows for extra breaks or extra time, should return their permission slip if they want to be dismissed after the test. However, they may not be finished by noon, and we will call you when they are ready for pick up. For those parents arriving at noon, please, plan to park in the front lot and wait for the students to be released, as you would for a regular

# **New Family Referral Program**

Our current Incarnation families are by far the best ambassadors for spreading the word about our school! Our New Family Referral Program rewards current families with a one-time \$250 tuition credit for referring a new family who applies and enrolls. Here's how it works:

- If you know of a family that you believe may be interested in School of the Incarnation, complete the "New Family Referral Form" below and submit to the school office.
- Reach out to the family and share your experiences at School of the Incarnation. Share with them the reasons you have chosen Catholic education and why you think they should do the same. Let them know that you have or will refer their information to the school and that an admissions representative will call or email them to provide more information.
- For each new family that applies and enrolls at least one full-time student, a \$250 tuition credit will be awarded to the current referring family after the new student has been in attendance for 30 days.
- Siblings of current students and previously enrolled students do not qualify as new families. Staff members are not eligible for the referral credit.
- Note that this form must be on file in the front office before the new family has contacted the school on their
  own for information or to visit so it is best to submit the form as soon as possible after speaking with the new
  family. In other words, the referral form is not retroactive and you are not eligible for the referral if the family
  contacts school before the referral.
- This referral program is open to all families with students currently enrolled in PreK4-Grade 8.
- Referral fees are limited to one per family per academic year.
