Attention 8th Grade Parents and Students - HSPT Registration

Registration for the High School Placement Test (HSPT) is now open. You may access the form via the following link, and our deadline for registration is Wednesday, November 23, 2022. Please, note that a \$40.00 fee is required to be paid online at the time of registration.

All our students will take the exam in school on Wednesday, November 30th, and it is important that they register to test at School of the Incarnation. High schools are listed first on the registration site, so you will need to scroll through those choices to find the elementary/middle schools toward the bottom of the page.

For students who qualify to receive accommodations, parents must upload official copies of educational test results by November 18th. This is a firm deadline because the system will lock afterward, preventing further uploads. Per Archdiocese requirements, a doctor's note or a copy of an accommodation plan will not suffice, and test results must be from at least 5th grade or more recent.

Reminder from the Health Room

Students may not possess, dispense, or distribute medication on their own. Under special circumstances, individual students may be authorized by their physician to carry and self-administer emergency medications (e.g., inhalers, epi-pens). In this case, the school nurse must be consulted. All medication must be delivered to school by a parent/guardian.

COVID Testing

Just as last year, SOTI has the ability to administer rapid COVID tests on-site in the case that a student is symptomatic in school and with the parent's consent. In order for us to administer a test, parents must complete the attached COVID-19 Testing Consent Form prior to the administration of a test. The school nurse will always contact a parent prior to the administration of a COVID test. However, if you would like to complete the form in advance to be kept on file, you may do so and send it in to the school nurse.

Please note: We do NOT test as a service/at the request of parents. The option/opportunity to test is at the discretion of the school nurse and administration.

I am Shannyn Petersen, the new music teacher here at SOTI. I am very excited to get started with the Choir program! Expectations/Rules:

<u>Cost:</u> The choir program is associated with the Beyond program at SOTI, but it follows a different timeline due to seasonal performances. The cost of the Choirs is as follows:

Cherub Choir: \$75 for half the year (Cherub Choir will end in December) Elementary & Middle Concert Choir: \$100 for the full year

<u>Attendance:</u> Performances are one of the major goals of singing in a Choir, and attendance at rehearsals is necessary in order to be successful during a performance. Students are more confident in front of an audience when they are well-rehearsed. Please check the dates below and make sure your child can attend most, if not all of the rehearsal dates listed before signing up.

<u>Behavior:</u> Choir is a team activity that depends on everyone working together. Students will be performing in front of an audience and are expected to have good performing etiquette during these performances. Any students who are not behaving well during rehearsals will most likely struggle during a performance. Students consistently not following the rules will be asked to leave the group.

<u>Performances:</u> Our first performances will be a bit more relaxed. The students will be learning proper vocal technique, how to blend, and to work together as a group. We will use familiar Christmas Carols in order to prepare to go caroling as our performance. Students will be expected to attend at least one caroling activity. Once we have established ourselves as a well-blended ensemble, we will move on to more challenging performance pieces. There will be a more formal Spring Concert in May. If you have a community or Church event that could use some carolers, please let me know and we will try to set up "gigs" for our Christmas carolers.

Dear School of the Incarnation Families,

School of the Incarnation is committed to proper safety measures, transparent communication, and adapting to changing COVID conditions. Our primary focus is on keeping the well-being of our students, faculty, and staff as our top priority.

In accord with the most recent guidance, we will report positive COVID- 19 cases on a weekly basis. School-wide notifications of such cases will be sent out on Thursdays via the School Newsletter. We will not be contact tracing and identifying close contacts within school.

The following positive Covid cases have been reported in our school community:

- Sixth grade student in Mrs. Goodman's homeroom. Last day in school was 9/7/22.
- Sixth grade student in Mrs. Goodman's homeroom. Last day in school was 9/9/22.
- Two Eighth grade siblings, one in Ms. Boretti's homeroom and one in Mrs. Hughes-Baldwin's homeroom. Last day in school was 9/9/22.

We encourage you to continue to actively monitor the health of your child daily and be alert to any of the major symptoms of COVID; including, but not limited to, fever, cough, sore throat, and shortness of breath. Masking is optional unless directed to do so by a health official after a quarantine. The school is not responsible for enforcing any individual masking preferences or obligations. Should any concerning symptoms appear, please contact your medical professional and alert the school office at 410-519-2285.

Should you wish to review additional information to address any questions regarding your child's potential exposure to a COVID-positive individual, we encourage you to visit the CDC, Maryland Department of Health, or local health department's websites. Thank you for your assistance in this process. We are grateful for your support and partnership.

"SCHOOL OF THE INCARNATION" (the "School"), is seeking your consent to test your child for SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes the novel coronavirus COVID-19. The School is partnering with the Maryland Department of Health (MDH) for a Program to provide onsite testing of students, teachers, staff, and volunteers at the School. This COVID-19 testing program is voluntary and meant to provide a convenient and prompt means to have your child tested for COVID-19 should your child meet the following **Testing Criteria:**

- (1) Exhibits one or more symptoms of COVID-19,
- (2) Comes in close contact with a student, teacher, staff member, or volunteer with COVID-19 or exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19, OR
- (3) Is selected as part of periodic or widespread surveillance testing on the School campus.

This Program is entirely voluntary and your child's education will in no way be affected by your decision of whether or not to participate in this program. You are not required to consent to testing or the release of information, but if you do not consent, the School will be unable to perform COVID-19 testing for your child.

When will testing occur? If you consent, your child will be tested if and when he/she meets the **Testing Criteria** described above. Your child may be tested multiple times if he/she meets the criteria on multiple occasions. Testing is expected to continue for so long as MDH continues to provide testing supplies to the School as part of this Program.

How will the testing be conducted? If you consent, your child will receive free diagnostic testing for the COVID-19 virus from the School nurse. Test specimens will be collected through a process that involves inserting a swab, similar to a Q-tip, into the nose. The specimens will be tested using one type of COVID-19 tests: (1) a Rapid Antigen Test (BinaxNOW COVID-19 Ag Card). This tests is designed to detect if your child currently has SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes the disease known as COVID-19. The results of this test will not tell you if your child had the virus in the past or has immunity from getting the virus in the future. For more information, please read the attached Patient Fact Sheets on the Abbott BinaxNow test.

When will test results be available? The Rapid Antigen Test does not require a clinical lab analysis and results will be available within approximately 15 minutes after the test is performed. The School will provide a copy of the Rapid Antigen Test results directly to you.

You should seek **emergency care immediately** if your child shows any of the following symptoms: trouble breathing, persistent pain or pressure in chest, new confusion, inability to wake or stay awake, bluish lips or face.

This list is not exhaustive; you should call your child's doctor immediately about any other symptoms that are severe or concerning to you.

What should I do when I receive my child's results? If your child's test results are positive, please contact your child's doctor immediately to review the results and discuss what you should do next. You should keep your child at home and keep the School informed. As further outlined in the attached Fact Sheets for Patients, negative results mean that the virus was not detected in your child's specimens. It is possible for the tests to produce incorrect negative results (called a "false negative") in some people who have COVID-19. If your child tests negative but has symptoms of COVID-19 or you have concerns about your child's exposure to COVID-19, you should call your child's doctor.

RELEASE OF INFORMATION

Information to be Released by School: By consenting to COVID-19 testing for your child, you authorize the School to release information and test results on your child to MDH for the purposes of performing COVID-19 public health surveillance purposes. The School may also be required by law to release test results on your child to federal, state, or local government authorities for public health surveillance and contact tracing purposes. Can I revoke this consent? You have the right to revoke this consent form at any time by delivering a written notice to the School Principal or designated School Administrator. Your revocation will be effective upon receipt but will not affect any testing or release of information that occurs prior to receipt.

- I have read and understand the information in this consent form and related documents and the School has answered any questions I have about the COVID-19 testing offered through this Program.
- I voluntarily agree to COVID-19 testing for my child, and I am legally authorized to make decisions for the child named above.
- I understand that If I am a student age 18 or older, or may otherwise legally consent for my own health care, references to "my child" refer to me and I may sign this form on my own behalf.
- I understand that my child may be tested multiple times during the school year if my child meets the **Testing Criteria** on multiple occasions.
- I acknowledge that a positive test result is an indication that my child must self-isolate and wear a mask, and that I am responsible for contacting my child's doctor to seek medical advice, care, and treatment.



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


