# Student Absence, Tardy or Leaving Early

Please remember to email <a href="mailto:attendance@schooloftheincarnation.org">attendance@schooloftheincarnation.org</a> and your child's homeroom teacher by 8:15 AM if your child will be absent, late or leaving early. Information in the email should include your child's full name and reason for absence, expected arrival time or expected early departure time.

# Early Dismissal/Late Arrival Protocol

At the front doors, there is a sign labeled "Sign In/Out," with a QR code. Parents signing in their child(ren) late to school should scan that QR code with their phone which will direct them to our digital Sign in/Sign Out Form. Once a parent has completed the sign in/sign out form, someone from the front office will admit the student into the building. To sign a student out for early dismissal, please follow the same procedure. Students will be released out the front door once the sign in/sign out form has been completed. Students leaving early must be signed out of school by 2:30 PM (11:30 AM on half days) so as not to disrupt our regular dismissal procedure.

### **School Mass**

School masses will usually be scheduled once a month beginning in September. Due to the number of students in grades Pre-K thru Grade 8, we unfortunately cannot accommodate parents at school masses in Marian Hall. Parents are always welcome to join us when mass is held outside in our parking lot or for morning prayer in Marian Hall every morning at 8:20 AM. Parents joining us for morning prayer should see our receptionist in the lobby to get a visitor badge. Thank you for your understanding.

## Spirit Wear Day – every Friday!!

Spirit wear days are distinct from out of uniform days and Tag days. Spirit wear days are special days designated by the principal when the students, faculty, and staff may come to school dressed in official School of the Incarnation spirit wear. These days usually fall on Friday or may be on a spirit night or any day designated by the principal. All spirit wear days will be listed on the calendar. Spirit wear days are optional, and if a student does not choose to dress in spirit wear on these days, he/she should come to school in the regular school uniform. The following are guidelines for spirit wear days:

- Students should wear an official School of the Incarnation spirit wear shirt\* which is one of the following acceptable school colors: maroon, gold/yellow, gray, white, or black.
- Any other School of the Incarnation spirit wear can be worn on these days with the exception of hats which may not be worn inside the building.
- Spirit wear that is defaced, torn, altered or written on is not permissible.
- Dresses and skirts must be of reasonable length (no more than 3 inches above the knee) and not too tight. No thin straps or bare shoulders.
- Pants Presentable jeans or pants are acceptable, but not pants that are tight. Sweatpants and joggers are acceptable. Opaque leggings or spandex are allowed only with an accompanying top which covers to mid-thigh. Pajama pants are not permitted. No rips, tears, or shear sections.
- Shorts may be worn from August-October 31st and April 1st-June.
- Hair may not be dyed or combed in an unusual fashion.
- When wearing shorts or skirts, these must be visible below the shirt. i.e. the shorts must be a modest length and should be long enough to be seen below the bottom of an oversized t-shirt or hoodie.
- Bike/spandex shorts for students in grades 3-8 are not permitted unless accompanied by a top which covers to mid-thigh. The shorts must be visible below the top.
- When the weather turns cold, spirit wear must be visible. For example: it would be unacceptable to be wearing a SOTI t-shirt which was completely covered by a Spalding sweatshirt.
- For students who have PE on Friday's, they are permitted to wear athletic Spirit Wear, and must also wear athletic shoes. (For example, they may wear a SOTI t-shirt with PE shorts/sweatpants, or other athletic shorts/sweatpants). Students are not permitted to wear jeans or other non-athletic apparel. Opaque leggings or spandex are allowed only with an accompanying top which covers to mid-thigh. No rips, tears, or shear sections. When wearing shorts or athletic skorts/skirts, these must be visible below the shirt. i.e. the shorts should be long enough to be seen below the bottom of an oversized t-shirt or hoodie. If non compliant, students will be asked to change into the PE uniform and issued a uniform infraction.
- If a student is improperly dressed, they will be given alternate clothing to wear or their parents will be called to take them home or bring a change of clothes.
- No hats are to be worn in school unless specified within the themes.
- Any shoes may be worn, except open-toed sandals, flip flops, clogs, thick-soled or high-heeled shoes.
   Crocs may be worn, but only in sport mode (strap around the back ankle)

 Earrings: Boys are not allowed to wear earrings at any time. Earrings for girls should be small posts or hoops.

\*Examples include: Always t-shirt, past school issued t-shirts of an approved color such as club shirts, SOTI PE t-shirt, or current SOTI athletic jerseys during the appropriate season.

Dear Parents, Students, Teachers, and Staff,

Tommy's Food Service will be serving our first lunch in the cafeteria on Monday, September 11, 2023. Kindergarten's lunch will start on Monday, October 2, 2023. The lunch menu for September, Tommy's Welcome Letter 2023 and "Tommy's 101" (cafeteria guidelines) will be posted on the School of the Incarnation website www.schooloftheincarnation.org

We will again be instituting a Lunch Account Debit System in the cafeteria this year whereby each student and staff member will have their own account number for purchases. We will be issuing lunch account numbers to new students prior to the first lunch day on September 11th. Returning students and staff will use the same account number. The amount you put on the Debit System will be at your own discretion depending on your anticipated purchases. We accept checks payable to: **Tommy's**, or cash in an envelope with your child's name or lunch account number for proper credit, or online payment via PayPal, just a friendly reminder that PayPal charges a fee not Tommy's. Go to <a href="www.paypal.com">www.paypal.com</a>, our merchant name is <a href="lunch@schooloftheincarnation.org">lunch@schooloftheincarnation.org</a>. <a href="There will be NO">There will be NO</a></a> <a href="CASH sales at the cash register">CASH sales at the cash register</a>. <a href="We would greatly appreciate that all accounts remain current, as this is a Debit Account System and not a Credit Account</a>. <a href="Lunch account history">Lunch account history</a> and account balance can be viewed at <a href="www.mymealmoney.com">www.mymealmoney.com</a>. All purchases remain on the system for 30 days.

<u>Due to rising minimum wage, food cost, the combo lunch cost is \$6.50</u> and it includes the entrée, choice of milk or juice or bottled water. The following items can be purchased separately: milk, fruit juices, bottled water, fruits, homemade soup, assorted subs (e.g. turkey or ham & cheese), assorted salads (e.g. tuna, chicken or egg), cookies, potato chips, yogurt and other snacks. Available daily except pizza day: hotdogs and grilled cheese sandwiches for \$2.75. Papa John's Pizza will be served on PIZZA Day the meal includes 1 slice of pizza and 1 milk for \$3.75 or just a slice for \$2.85. Tommy's food service uses complete oven baking system. We do not fry any food and are a peanut free kitchen.

We strive to provide a variety of your child's favorite foods and healthy snacks, as well as a pleasant experience for you. We do not fry any foods, and prepare most items from scratch each morning using the highest quality products available. Many of our recipes have been in the family for years. **WE WILL BE SERVING OUR FIRST LUNCH ON MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 11, 2023.** 

# **School Lunch Accounts 101**

It is very important to remember that lunch accounts utilize a debit system – there is no credit. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to fund the account, monitor purchases online, and discuss purchasing habits with their child. We ask that you maintain a positive balance of \$20.00 in the account. 

Due to rising minimum wage, food cost, the combo lunch cost is \$6.50 it includes an entrée, milk or juice or bottled water. The average student spends about \$25/week when purchasing daily lunch and occasional snacks

# **Funding the Lunch Account**

There are several ways to add money to your child's lunch account. We accept checks; cash in an envelope with your child's full name and online payments via PayPal. Just a friendly reminder that PayPal charges a fee of 2.9% + 30 cents will be deducted. Please make checks payable to *Tommy's* in an envelope with your child's full name or lunch account number on the memo line for proper credit. \*\*There is a \$30 NSF (non-sufficient fund) fee assessed to the lunch account for each returned check. This covers our bank fees.

To send a payment via PayPal, you may go directly to <a href="www.paypal.com">www.paypal.com</a> our merchant name is <a href="www.paypal.com">lunch@schooloftheincarnation.org</a> Always include your child's full name or lunch account number for proper credit. Just a friendly reminder that PayPal charges a fee of 2.9% + 30 cents will be deducted (by PayPal, not Tommy's) and the adjusted amount will be credited to your lunch account on the next business day.

# **Negative Account Policy**

Students will be told verbally when they reach a \$0.00 balance, and email notice when the account reaches (-\$5.00). Email notices will be sent out weekly. Students with negative account will only be given the lunch of the day (no extras, e.g. cookies and no seconds). Currently, we do not charge any fees if the account falls negative.

Being told they have a zero or negative balance can be upsetting or embarrassing for some students, so please make sure they understand if there is no money in the account, they cannot purchase extras. We try to be flexible and gentle, always giving students a verbal warning when they are approaching the "No Snack Zone".

# **Monitoring Accounts Online**

Go to the <a href="www.mymealmoney.com">www.mymealmoney.com</a> select your school, enter the last name, and ID # in the respective fields. Instead of pressing the enter key on your keyboard, you'll need to manually click on the green GO button. You will see an overview of your child's account in the yellow box immediately below. Parenthesis around the amount (\$0.00) indicates a negative balance. Once you see your child's name and homeroom information, then you can click on the History button to the left to view account details and 30 days of history. Current day history is available after 3:00pm. \*The website is not supported on Internet Explorer 9 Beta.

# **Purchasing Habits**

Please consider this a great opportunity to discuss healthy eating habits with your child and begin teaching them about basic money management. These life skills truly begin at home.

We understand that students don't always respect their parent's instructions. If your child does not have your permission to use a lunch account, you must notify Tommy's in writing and bring the account to a zero balance before it will be closed. Otherwise, accounts remain open and available for use.





# **New Family Referral Program**

Our current Incarnation families are by far the best ambassadors for spreading the word about our school! Our New Family Referral Program rewards current families with a one-time \$250 tuition credit for referring a new family who applies and enrolls. Here's how it works:

- If you know of a family that you believe may be interested in School of the Incarnation, complete the "New Family Referral Form" below and submit to the school office.
- Reach out to the family and share your experiences at School of the Incarnation. Share with them the reasons you have chosen Catholic education and why you think they should do the same. Let them know that you have or will refer their information to the school and that an admissions representative will call or email them to provide more information.
- For each new family that applies and enrolls at least one full-time student, a \$250 tuition credit will be awarded to the current referring family after the new student has been in attendance for 30 days.
- Siblings of current students and previously enrolled students do not qualify as new families. Staff members are not eligible for the referral credit.
- Note that this form must be on file in the front office before the new family has contacted the school on their
  own for information or to visit so it is best to submit the form as soon as possible after speaking with the new
  family. In other words, the referral form is not retroactive and you are not eligible for the referral if the family
  contacts school before the referral.
- This referral program is open to all families with students currently enrolled in PreK4-Grade 8.
- Referral fees are limited to one per family per academic year.
